HAITIAN NEIGHBORHOOD CENTER HOSTS PASSPORT DAY

Miami, FL (November 28, 2007) – The Haitian Neighborhood Center, Sant La, is bringing passport application services to the Haitian-American community on Wednesday, December 5, 2007 from 9 AM to 3 PM at Sant La, 5000 Biscayne Boulevard, Suite 110, Miami. Creole-speaking personnel from the U.S. Department of State Bureau of Consular Affairs Miami Passport Agency will be on hand to answer questions and assist with applying for passports for naturalized or US-born Haitian-Americans. Children under the age of 14 require parental consent and evidence of citizenship, relationship and identification. All individuals applying for passports must have two color passport photos, identification, proof of citizenship, and a check in the amount of \$97 (16 years or older) or \$82 (15 years and younger).
